

Bankwest Ideas Lab App Survey Competition – NSW

Terms and Conditions:

1. This Competition commences at 12:01am AWST on 14 April 2021 and closes at 11:59pm AWST on 3 May 2021 (“Promotional Period”). Taking part in this Competition constitutes acceptance of these terms and conditions.
2. Bankwest, a division of Commonwealth Bank of Australia ABN 48 123 123 124 AFSL / Australian credit licence 234945, Bankwest Place, 300 Murray St, Perth WA 6000, phone 13 17 19, is the promoter of this Competition (“Promoter” or “Bankwest”). The promotion is governed by the laws of New South Wales.
3. Entry is open to Australian residents (“Eligible Entrants”) who:
 - a. Reside in New South Wales; and
 - b. Are a current member of the Ideas Lab panel on the date of the draw (‘Eligible Entrants’). To become a member of the Ideas Lab panel you must:
 - Receive an invitation from the Promoter to participate in the Bankwest Ideas Lab Panel (by way of an email, online advertising or any other media);
