

Before the Bounce Giveaway Competition

Terms and Conditions

- 1. This competition commences at 10:00am AEST on 5 May, 2024 and closes at 12:00pm AEST on 5 May, 2024 ('Promotional Period'). Taking part in this competition constitutes acceptance of these terms and conditions.
- 2. Bankwest, a division of Commonwealth Bank of Australia ABN 48 123 123 124 AFSL/Australian credit licence 234945, Bankwest Place, 300 Murray St, Perth WA 6000, ph. 13 17 19, is the promoter of this competition ('Promoter') authorised under the promotion governed by the laws of Western Australia and each entrant agrees to submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of Western Australia.
- 3. Entry is open to Australian residents ('Eligible Entrants') who:
 - a) Reside in Victoria; and
 - b) Are a Bankwest customer and/ or Fremantle Football Club 2024 member; and

 12pm AEST on 5 May, 2024; and
 - b) Minor prize commences 10:00am AEST on 5 May, 2024 and ends 12pm AEST on 5 May, 2024.

 - a) For **Major prize**, the first one (1) eligible entry drawn is in the promotional period; and
 - b) For **Minor prize** the first four (4) eligible entries drawn are in the promotional period;

 - b) Any theft, unauthorised access or third party interference;
