

Leeds FC Player Mascot Competition

Wanderers FC vs. Leeds FC

How to enter:

To be in the running to win one (1) of three (3) Leeds player mascot prizes to Wanderers FC v Leeds FC football match at Bankwest Stadium on 20 July 2019, comment below the Facebook post – telling us why your son or daughter should be selected as a Leeds player mascot.

Terms and Conditions

1. The Bankwest, Wanderers FC v Leeds FC Player Mascot Facebook Competition (“Competition”) commences at 9:00 am AEST on 10th July 2019 and closes at 11:59pm AEST on the 16th July 2019 (“Promotional Period”). Taking part in this Competition constitutes acceptance of these terms and conditions. The Promoter is Bankwest, a division of Commonwealth Bank of Australia ABN 48 123 123 124 AFSL/Australian credit licence 234945 300 Murray Street, Perth WA 6000 (“Bankwest” or “Promoter”).
2. To be eligible for entry (“Entrant”) in the Competition you must (“Eligibility Criteria”):
 - a. Entry of the competition must be submitted by the parent(s) or guardian(s) and be aged over 18.
 - b. Entrants must be a resident of New South Wales.
 - c. Children being nominated as mascots by the entrants must be aged 6 – 9 years old
3. To enter, Entrants must comment on the nominated Facebook post and tell us why their son or daughter should be a Leeds FC player mascot during the Promotional Period (“Entry Requirements”).

4. There is a limit of one (1) entry per person. Entrants who post an answer more than once will be ineligible.
5. Valid Entries are entries that satisfy the Entry Requirements and are in line with the Bankwest social media house rules

6. The Winners of the competition will be determined by a panel of representatives from Bankwest on 17 July 2019 at 10:00am AEST (“Judging Date”) at Bankwest, Level 17, 45 Clarence Street, Sydney NSW 2000. Entries will be judged based on creativity.
7. The Winners will be notified in writing on the Bankwest Facebook page by a response to their post on 17 July 2019 by 2:00pm AEST. Winners will then be required to privately message their email address and contact phone number to the Bankwest Facebook page, so that they may be identified and to claim their Prize. Prizes will then be made available for collection via email. There are three (3) prizes to be won, each consisting of three (3) general admission tickets to the Wanderers v Leeds event at Bankwest Stadium on 20 July 2019 (“Event”), valued at \$300.00 per person (“Prize”). Total prize pool is \$900.00.
8. If a Winner selected is not able to be contacted by 9:00am AEST on 18th July 2019, the Prize will be forfeited, and another winner will be selected by a Bankwest representative in the same place and manner as clause 7 on 17th July 2019 at 10:00am AEST.

If any prize remains unclaimed after 3 months of the draw, the Promoter will conduct an unclaimed prize draw in the same manner and place as the original draw, subject to any directions from the Office of Liquor, Gaming and Racing (NSW) or given under Regulation 37 of the *Lottery and Gaming Regulations 1993* (SA).
