

Terms and Conditions - Wanderers FC v Leeds United Parramatta Branch Competition

Terms and Conditions

1. This competition commences at 9:00 am AEST on 8th July 2019 and closes at 3.30pm AEST on Saturday 13th July 2019 ("Promotional Period"). Taking part in this Competition constitutes acceptance of these terms and conditions.
2. Bankwest, a division of Commonwealth Bank of Australia ABN 48 123 123 124 AFSL / Australian credit license 234945, Bankwest Place, 300 Murray St, Perth WA 6000, phone 13 17 19 is the promoter of this Competition ("Bankwest").
3. Entry is open to Australian residents ('Eligible Entrants') who:
