

‘Lift and Win’ Giveaway Competition

Terms and Conditions

1. This competition commences at 5:30pm AWST on 23 July 2026 and closes at 8:00pm AWST on 23 July 2026 (‘Promotional Period’). Taking part in this competition constitutes acceptance of these terms and conditions.
2. Bankwest, a division of Commonwealth Bank of Australia ABN 48 123 123 124 AFSL/Australian credit licence 234945, Bankwest Place, 300 Murray St, Perth WA 6000, ph. 13 17 19, is the promoter of this competition (‘Promoter’) authorised under the promotion governed by the laws of Western Australia and each entrant agrees to submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of Western Australia.
3. Entry is open to Australian residents (‘Eligible Entrants’) who:
 - a. Reside in Western Australia; and
 - b. are aged over 18.
4. Eligible Entrants declare that they enter the Promotion in a wholly personal, private or domestic capacity and not in relation to any enterprise e.g. business undertaking.
5. To enter, Eligible Entrants must attend the designated Bankwest event on 23 July 2026 located at Westfield Booragoon Shopping Centre – 125 Riseley St, Booragoon WA 6154 and register their participation as follows:
 - a. Upon arrival at the Event, Eligible Entrants must collect one (1) raffle ticket;
 - b. Retain raffle ticket(s) for participation in the competition conducted at the Event.
 - c. During the Event, raffle ticket numbers will be drawn at random by a nominated event host;



- d. Entrants whose ticket numbers are drawn will be invited to participate in an on-stage activity for the opportunity to win a prize, including selecting and revealing a prize via a “game board” mechanic;
 - e. Prizes will be awarded based on the outcome of the game board selection, as determined at the Event.
- 6. Eligible Entrants will receive one (1) raffle ticket (maximum of one (1) entry per person).
- 7. Prizes will be awarded at the Event through the game of chance described in clause 5. The number of prizes available will be determined by the Promoter and may vary based on the number of prize opportunities conducted during the Event.
- 8. Winners will be determined at the designated Bankwest event on 23 July 2026, located at Westfield Booragoon Shopping Centre – 125 Riseley St, Booragoon WA 6154 in accordance with the process outlined in clause 5.
- 9. The winner(s) will be notified at the Event at the time of winning.
- 10. There is one (1) major prize consisting of:
 - a. Two tickets into the Tom Wills Room to Round 22 AFL match (Melbourne v Fremantle) on Saturday 8 August 2026. Tickets include premium Level 2 reserved seating, three course meal, premium beverage package and reserved table throughout the match and valued at \$395.00 each.
 - b. Two return flights* from Perth to Melbourne with Virgin Australia on the Fremantle Football Club Charter Flight or, if unavailable, on a commercial flight to be determined at the Promoter’s discretion. Flights are valued at up to \$850.00 per person.
 - c. Two nights’ accommodation* in a twin share room at the Sheraton Melbourne Hotel (subject to availability). Accommodation valued at \$540.00. Prices may vary depending on room availability.
- 11. There are four (4) secondary prizes consisting of:
 - a. Four (4) double passes (eight (8) tickets total) to the Round 20 AFL Match (Fremantle Dockers v West Coast Eagles) on Friday 24 July 2026 (valued at \$119 per ticket); and



- b. Four (4) double Guard of Honour experiences with the Fremantle Dockers on game day (eight (8) individual participant positions in total), valued at \$200 per experience.
- 12. Prize(s) is/are not transferable or redeemable for cash. The total prize pool value is up to \$5,582. Prize valuation is accurate as of 27 May 2026. Subject to change.
- 13. Prizes must be claimed at the Event at the time they are awarded. If an entrant whose raffle ticket is drawn is not present at the Event or does not respond within 60 seconds of their ticket number being called, they will forfeit their opportunity to participate. In this instance, the Promoter reserves the right to draw an alternative raffle ticket and proceed with the prize allocation process. No redraws will occur after the Event.
- 14. Travel to and from the Venue and any other travel associated costs in accepting a Prize (including but not limited to transportation to and from the airport), is the sole responsibility of the Winner and its guest. This excludes the return flights per person included between Perth, Western Australia and Melbourne, Victoria. Additionally, all other ancillary costs (including but not limited to travel insurance) shall be borne by the Winner.
- 15. In accepting and using the Prize, the Winner agrees to comply with the Fremantle Football Club Charter Flight Booking Terms and Conditions provided ahead of their flight and the Venue's [condition of entry](#).
- 16. If the Prize, or any element of the Prize with the Fremantle Football Club becomes unavailable for any reason the Promoter may, in its sole and absolute discretion, modify or substitute the Prize.
- 17. As a condition of claiming the Prize, the winner(s) consent to the Promoter using their name, likeness, image and/or voice (including photograph, film and/or recording) in any media for an unlimited period without remuneration for the purpose of promoting this Competition (including any outcome), the Promoter and its products and services.



The winner(s) also consent to the Promoter sharing their information as provided in their entry for the purpose of media or other publicity activities relating to the Competition.

18. Bankwest accepts no responsibility for loss or damage to prizes in transit.
19. No correspondence will be entered into. The Promoter's decision is final.
20. Directors and employees of the Commonwealth Bank Group including their immediate families, its agencies and companies associated with this competition, and employees and immediate family members of companies associated with the Venue, are not eligible to enter.

To the extent permitted by law, the Promoter and the Venue, and each of their related entities and their respective directors, officers, employees and agents, will not be liable for any personal injury, loss or damage, whatsoever which is suffered or sustained (including, but not limited to indirect or consequential, financial or other loss) to or by an Entrant or the Winner/s and their guest.

The Winner/s of the Prize accept the Prize 'as is' and acknowledges that the Promoter accepts no responsibility for any tax implications that may arise from their use of the receipt and use of the Prize. Beneficiaries of the Prizes should seek their own personal advice from the Australian Tax Office or their own taxation adviser or independent financial adviser.
23. The Promoter reserves the right, at any time, in its sole discretion, to verify the validity of entries and Eligible Entrants (including an Entrant's identity, age, place of residence) and reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any Entrant whom the Promoter has reason to believe has breached any of these terms, tampered with the entry process or engaged in any unlawful or other improper misconduct calculated to jeopardise fair and proper conduct of the Promotion. The Promoter's legal rights to recover damages or other compensation from such an offender are reserved.
24. If for any reason this Promotion is not capable of running as planned (including, but not limited to infection by computer virus, bugs, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical



failures or any other causes beyond the control of the Promoter which corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of this Promotion), the Promoter may, subject to the approval of all relevant regulatory authorities, take any action that may be available including cancelling, terminating, modifying or suspending the Promotion.

25. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.
26. Nothing in these terms limits, excludes or modifies or purports to limit, exclude or modify the statutory consumer guarantees as provided under the Competition and Consumer Act, as well as any other implied warranties under the ASIC Act or similar consumer protection laws in the states and territories of Australia (Non-Excludable Guarantees).
27. Except for any liability that cannot by law be excluded, including the Non-Excludable Guarantees, the Promoter and its related entities (including its respective directors, officers, employees and agents) are not responsible for and exclude all liability (including negligence), for any personal injury; or any loss or damage (including loss of opportunity); whether direct, indirect, special or consequential, arising in any way out of:
 - a. Any technical difficulties or equipment malfunction (whether or not under the Promoter's control);
 - b. Any theft, unauthorised access or third party interference;
 - c. Any entry or Prizes claim that is late, lost, altered, damaged or misdirected (whether or not after their receipt by the Promoter) due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter;
 - d. Any variation in Prizes value to that stated in these terms;
 - e. Any tax liability incurred by a beneficiary of a Prize (including an Entrant and the Prize Recipient);
 - f. Use/taking of the Prize;
 - g. The Promotion.
